

Nomadic Naadam Festival

5nights / 6days – Event tours

Mongol Nomadic Naadam is an activity-packed tour to explore cultural heritages in Central Mongolia, an area of varied landscapes and the nomadic heartland of the country. See the Khognokhan Nature Reserve, the dunes at Elsen Tasarkhai, and the ancient Mongol capital the Kharakhorum, venturing to the Hustai National Park for the wild Takhi horses and a plethora of wildlife before you experience Mongol Nomadic Naadam, Naadam is inseparably connected to the nomadic civilization of the Mongols, who have long practised pastoralism on Central Asia's vast steppe.

Activities: Exploring cultural heritage sites, local Naadam Festival, exploring varied natural landscapes, experiencing nomadic culture and lifestyle

- **Duration:** 5nights / 6days
- **Distance:** 850kms
- **Group size:** Min-2, Max – 6pax
- **Season:** June – mid Sep 2025



Day 1 Welcoming day

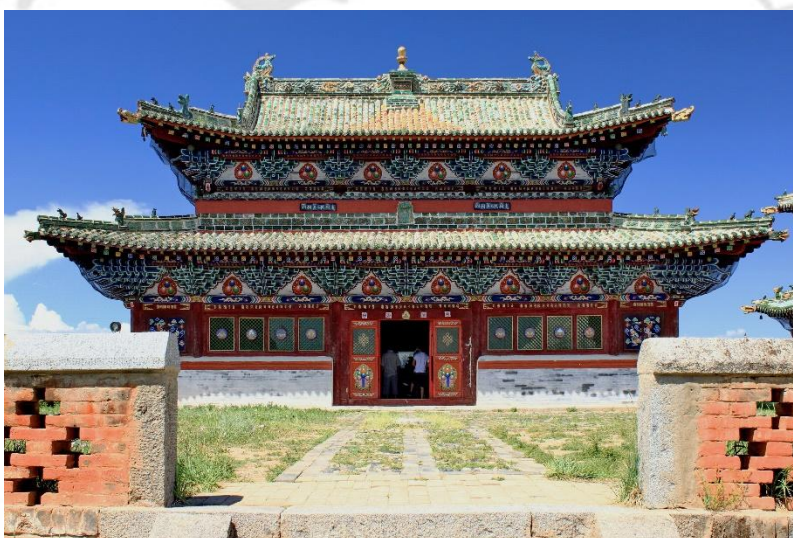
Arrive in Ulaanbaatar the capital city of Mongolia. Transfer to your hotel. Visit National museum of Mongolia. Walking through the Sukhbaatar Square. In the evening enjoy traditional art performance. Welcome dinner. Stay overnight in the hotel. **LD**



Day 2 Travel to Khognokhan Mountain

Travel to Khognokhan Mountain Natural Reserve for 280kms, the unique combination where mountains, forest and Gobi-type landscapes are all in one location. Visit a camel herder family. Enjoy an hour camel riding through sand dunes. Stay overnight in Ger camp. **BLD**

Day 3 Travel to Kharakhorum

Travel to the Kharakhorum the ancient capital of Mongolia where Chinggis Khaan established his headquarters in 1220. In 1235, his son and successor, Ogodei built a palace enclosed by walls. You will visit an interesting local museum showcasing the Mongolian Past and Erdenezuu Monastery, the largest and first Mongolian Buddhist temple complex built on the remains of 16th-century

Kharakhorum city. Then we will visit a local cooperative to attend a workshop for making felt items by hand. Stay overnight in Ger camp. **BLD**



Day 4 Travel to Hustai National Park

Travel to Hustai National Park for 240km. Hustai National Park encompasses an area of 50.620 hectares, which is the habitat of reintroduction wild Mongolian horses, popularly known as Takhi (Przewalski's Horse). Explore the park to see the Takhi horses in the wilderness. Stay overnight in Ger camp. **BLD**

Lunch at Ger camp restaurant.

Afternoon enjoy Mongol Nomadic Naadam festival.

All visitors will be greeted and welcomed to the arena to join the Naadam.



The event will begin with a Mongolian long song & horse head fiddle performance according to Mongolian tradition. Then 16 strong wrestlers compete for 1st round of wrestling. Archery competition and ankle bone shooting competition will be followed afterwards. Local artists perform

Mongolian dances and national songs.

Guests would be welcomed to get real experience for archery and ankle bone shooting. And all guests would see how nomads transport loads with ox cart.



Then most interesting part of Naadam festival, the horse racing will be started. Little jockeys sing Giingoo – a special song/mantra for racing horses... The winners of the competitions will be awarded with sheep and other traditional gifts of nomads. You have many opportunities to meet with wrestlers, jockeys, archers and take memorable photos. Late afternoon drive to Ulaanbaatar. Guided shopping for cashmere and souvenirs. Enjoy the Farewell dinner. Stay overnight in hotel. **BLD**
